

Font support for windows operating systems

Font support for windows XP

- Enable the Indian language support using **Control Panel --> Regional Options**
- Click on Regional and Language Options.
- Click on languages tab.
- Under the heading 'Supplemental language support' check the item 'Install files for Complex Script and right-to-left languages (including Thai)'.
- Allow the OS to install necessary files from WindowsXP disc.
- Restart the operating system.

Font support for windows 2000

- Copy any Unicode Kannada font (preferably a licensed Tunga font) to WINNT->FONTS folder.
- Copy and paste USP10.DLL file to Program files→Internet Explorer folder.
- Still if you are not able to see the font go to view-> encoding (In Internet Explorer) change Encoding to Unicode.

Font support for windows 98

- Copy any Unicode Kannada font (preferably a licensed Tunga font). To font folder.
- Completely uninstall the IE, and install the latest Internet Explorer on your windows 98 installation (i.e IE 6).
- Add "Arabic support" while installation.
- Restart the Operating system
